COMMISSION FOR LABOR COOPERATION (OF NORTH AMERICA)	The commision is comprised of the Labor Secretaries and Ministers of the US, Mexico and Canada, and their representatives under the provisions set by the North American Agreement on Labor Coordination (NAALC).
COMMISSION FOR THE PRESERVATION OF AMERICAN HERITAGE ABROAD	The commission identifies, monitors and promotes the preservation of largely Jewish histoical sites in Central and Eastern Europe
COMMISSION FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF TEXTILE AGREEMENTS	The interagency group chaired by the Department of Commerce is responsible for matters affecting textile trade policy and supervising implementation of all textile trade agreements.
COMMISSION ON PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARS (PRESIDENT'S SCHOLARS PROGRAM)	The Commission on Presidential Scholars is a group of eminent private citizens appointed by the President to select and honor the Presidential Scholars.
COMMISSION ON SECURITY AND COOPERATION IN EUROPE (HELSINKI COMMISSION)	The Commission monitors and encourages compliance with the Helsinki Final Act and other commitments by members of the OSCE, as well as assesses the development of democratic, economic and human rights in memeber countries in Europe.
COMMITTEE FOR PURCHASE FROM PEOPLE WHO ARE BLIND OR SEVERELY DISABLED	The Commission determines which products and services purchased by the Federal Government must be procured from Ability-One-participating nonprofit agencies; establishes the fair market prices for these products and services; and ensures that non profit groups comply with Committee rules and regulations.

COMMODITY CREDIT CORPORATION, BOARD OF DIRECTORS	The government-owned CCC was established in 1933 to stabilize, support and protect farm income and prices.
COMMODITY FUTURES TRADING COMMISSION	CFTC protects market users and the public from fraud, manipulation, and abusive practices related to the sale of commodity and financial futures and options.
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY BOARD	The CDA board advises the Director of the Treasury Department's Community Financial Institutions Fund on the policies, which are to expand financial services to distressed urban and rural areas.
COORDINATED COUNCIL FOR JUVENILE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION	The independent body in the executive branch coordinates federal juvenile and delinquency programs, federal programs or activities that detain or care of unaccompanied juveniles and federal programs that pertain to missing and exploited children.

ENDANGERED SPECIES COMMITTEE	The private, public committee monitors the legislation and policy affecting endangered species.

FARM CREDIT ADMINISTRATION	The FCA monitors the Farm Credit System (FCS), a nationwide network of borrower-owned lending institutions that provide services for farmers, ranchers, agricultural cooperatives and other qualified borrowers.
FEDERAL ACCOUNTING STANDARDS ADVISORY BOARD	The FASAB promotes federal accounting and reporting standards.
FEDERAL AGRICULTURE MORTGAGE CORPORATION, BOARD OF DIRECTORS (FARMER MAC)	FARMERMAC was estblihsed in 1998 to form a secondary market for agricultural real estate loan and rural housing mortgage loan.
FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION	The FCC regulates interstate and internaional communications by radio, television, wire, satellite and cable.
FEDERAL DEPOSIT INSURANCE CORPORATION	The FDIC preserves and promotes confidence in the US financial system by insuring deposits in banks and thrift institutions.
FEDERAL ELECTION COMMISSION	The FEC administers and enforces the Federal Election Campaign Act (FECA), the statute that governs the financing of Federal elections.

FEDERAL MARITIME COMMISSION	The FMC is responsible for the regulation of ocean carriers, marine terminal operators, conferences, ports and ocean transportation intermediaries.
FEDERAL MEDIATION AND CONCILIATION SERVICE	The Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service is an independent agency of the United States Government, founded in 1947, which provides mediation services to industry, community and government agencies worldwide; one its most common tasks is to help to mediate labor disputes around the country.
FEDERAL MINE SAFETY AND HEALTH REVIEW COMMISSION	The Federal Mine Safety and Health Review commission is an independent adjudicative agency of the United States Government that provides administrative trial and appellate review of legal disputes arising under the Federal Mine Safety and Health Amendments Act, or Mine Act, of 1977
