The National Hispana Leadership Institute Announces its 2013 Latinas Learning to Lead Program Fellows

Washington, DC – The National Hispana Leadership Institute (NHLI) announces its 2013 Latinas Learning to Lead Program fellows. After a competitive application process, 22 Latina college students have been selected to participate in a week-long intensive professional development and leadership training program. The program will be held at The Catholic University of America July 21-27, 2013.

“We received an incredible pool of talented young women and I am very excited to be able to meet each of the 22 fellows. The Latinas Learning to Lead Program will be a great opportunity for each of them to develop their budding leadership skills and pave the way for success in the future,” said Ann Marquez, President of the National Hispana Leadership Institute.

This year’s class comes from 13 different states across the nation and they represent a variety of fields of study. Participants were selected based on their community service record, professional and personal accomplishments, and dedication to serving their community.

NHLI’s annual Latinas Learning to Lead Program promotes and fosters the development of college-age Latina leaders through training, mentoring opportunities, access to national networks and tools to create a community impact through their leadership projects. Some session topics will include public speaking skills, resume building, and effective listening. This year’s class will also participate in a new component of the program. Each fellow will shadow an NHLI alumna from the Executive Leadership Program for one day. Alumnae of the Executive Leadership Program have over 10 years of working experience and have undergone training at Harvard University and the Center for Creative Leadership as part of NHLI’s ELP.
